Classroom Behavior Expectations:

1. Follow all district policies.
2. Cell phones are not to be used during the school day without permission. They will stay in lockers or pockets in the classroom.
3. It is your responsibility to charge your devices every night so they are fully charged for the school day.
4. Be respectful, kind, and responsible!
5. Clean up after yourself before leaving the classroom.
6. Leave others' belongings alone.
7. Cheating will not be tolerated and will result in immediate dispatching to the office.
8. Bullying will not be tolerated and will result in immediate dispatching to the office.
9. Any time there is a disciplinary or academic issue, parents, coaches, and/or directors will all be contacted by email.

Advisory Expectations:

1. You must have a pass from the teacher you are going to during advisory in order to leave the room.
2. Academics supersede any other meetings during advisory. You may only attend if no work is owed.
3. You will read silently or work on assignments.
4. No talking.

Supplies for Core Courses:

Students must have their laptop in every class.

- English—notebook paper, pencils, 1 ½ inch binder, set of 5 dividers
- History— composition book
- Math—3 inch binder, package of 5 dividers, notebook paper
- Reading— 1 ½ inch binder and 5 dividers
- Science— composition notebook, plastic folder

Planners:

- Each student will be given a planner to keep track of assignments and due dates.
- If a student loses their planner, there will be a \$5 charge to the office to replace the planner.
- All hall passes and disciplinary bucks will be kept in the planner.

Plagiarism and Cheating:

Scholastic dishonesty, which includes, but is not limited to, cheating on a test, plagiarism, or unauthorized collaboration with another person in preparing written work will not be tolerated.

Honor Code Statement:

On my honor as a student of Shallowater Middle School, I will neither give nor receive unauthorized answers from any source for any work in this class.

Grading Policy:

- Corrections
 - Only Assessments may be corrected.
 - If corrections are completed correctly, per the teacher's instructions, students may earn up to half credit back.
 - All corrections must be turned in within ONE WEEK after the student has received the graded assessment.
- No extra credit is available.
- Assessments (tests, quizzes, projects, essays) = 70%
- Daily Work (everything else)= 30%
- Late work
 - Lunch detention will be assigned immediately if the work is not turned in on the due date.
 - 10 points off the grade for each day late up to THREE days; after the THIRD day, the grade is a zero

- For math: If an assignment is not turned in when it is due, that student will serve lunch detention in the math classroom until work is completed and turned in. They will eat lunch in the classroom while working.
- Absent work - The student will have ONE calendar day for each absent day to complete assignments.

Technology Expectations:

- Students may only use the applications or programs allowed by the teacher.
- Demonstrate patience and listening skills by waiting and listening for teacher instructions before proceeding with the activity.
- Off-topic surfing the Internet is not permitted. Use of any inappropriate websites will result in direct office referral.
- No food, gum, or drinks should be near the equipment.
- Be sure your laptop is charged every night.

Students will be upheld to all the standards and requirements listed in the Acceptable Use Policy as outlined in the Shallowater ISD Student Handbook which can be found at the district website.

Virtual Classroom Expectations (if needed):

In the event that the district or campus goes to distance learning, the following expectations are in place, but can also change. We will communicate any changes as soon as we know them.

- Meet in an area with minimal audio and visual distractions for you and the people in the meeting.
- You may not use any other technology unless the teacher says to. This includes: phones, iPads, tablets, game systems, television, smart watches, streaming music, and anything else not listed that you would try to use.
- Have all of the materials you will need, paper, pencil/pen, book, colored pencils, print outs, Post-it notes, and anything else designated for the assignment.
- When you log into the virtual classroom platform, make sure your mic is MUTED and video is ON.
- When you have a question, type it into CHAT and click on the RAISE HAND icon.
- You must stay in attendance for the entire meeting.
- Follow school dress code.
